
Kourtney Kardashian







Kirk Knight



Ashton Kutcher






While in college, the performer was the president and musical director of a jazz and pop a cappella group. During these years, he was in a number of shows around Philadelphia,

In 2007, Lively landed the role that put her on the map on The CW's hit teen drama *Gossip Girl*. Her performance as Serena van der Woodsen brought her to the limelight, and her face was everywhere. A year later, she won two more Teen Choice Awards for Television Actress and Television Breakout Star for her role on the series. With her good looks, natural acting talent, and devoted fan base, it was not hard for her career to continue to grow. She landed roles in films including *The Town*, *Green Lantern*, *Savages*, *The Age of Adeline*, and most recently in *The Shallows*.

Lindsay Lohan







Jennifer Lopez





Joel Madden







Katie Maloney






Katie Maloney stars in Bravo's hit reality TV show Vanderpump

Joe Manganiello







The singer continued to have extreme success with his next album Continuum, and it was his third studio album to go platinum. In 2009, he won two more Grammy awards for the songs "Say" and "Gravity" on Continuum. That same year, he released his next album Battle Studies, which also topped the charts.

John Mayer admitted that he fell in love, and many questioned if his popular single "Your Body is a Wonderland" was written about the curvy actress.
