
Beauty Tips: Colored Eyeliner



2. Stability: Children tend to grow up in a more stable environment if their parents are married. Married couples are also able to show their children more attention, while a single parent may not always have the time.






3. No strings attached: One of the best things about keeping

Cupid's Advice:


The timing is really important in a relationship, as well as making sure you don't change for them. It's always better to find someone who shares similar beliefs. Cupid has some hints:

Cupid's Advice:


Breakups are never a pleasant experience, but why is it that former couples so readily turn against each other after a split? Cupid has some ideas:

Who should move out of your shared home after a split?


Cupid's advice:


Constant dating can become routine for many, but it's important to know when you have genuinely struck gold. Here are a few signs that your relationship is on the right track:


