In 2002, they released their second album *The Young & the Hopeless*, which sold over five million copies worldwide. The band's stardom continued to grow — they were known for being the "not so punk" punk band — and they even graced the cover of *Rolling Stone* magazine.

Joel Madden began dating Disney darling Hilary Duff when he was 25 years old and she was only 16 years old. Their age difference sparked a lot of celebrity gossip, although the famous couple denied their relationship until three months before Duff turned 18.
