"Although it's about a one night stand and the complete opposite of love, it's such a powerful message," she says.

## You & A Music Host Talks About Her Relationship and Love

Despite her fondness for unhappy love songs, the host makes it clear that her own love life is far from depressing. Having been in a long-distance relationship for over three years, she believes that "communication is the most important thing. Even if it's just sending a sweet little text or making sure you speak before going to sleep, it's important to talk to your partner every day. It's nice to have that time together on the phone."
