
Adrianne Curry and Christopher Knight Split



1. No drama: If your mate makes a big deal out of the smallest issues, talk to him or her about it. Sure, relationships take



and opening up about his long time drug addiction.




The stakes were high at the end of the Vegas trip as Ashley

- 2. Take candid pictures: The beginning of any relationship is considered the "honeymoon" stage, so why not keep those


memories alive by taking pictures of all the fun times you two are having together? This way, you'll always remember the fun you had from the very start.

1. Destination wedding: This may be expensive, but why not go


all out? Everyone can meet up and take a cruise through the tropics while you two exchange vows at sea.

Not all loves in this world are supposed to last. Cupid has a few suggestions on how to know when it's time to leave:


- 1. Where is the love?: If the love and connection you used to your feel with your partner has now vanished or decreased significantly, it may be time to re-evaluate your relationship.

Cupid's Advice:


Learning about a partner's affair is tough, and there are lots of different ways to react. Cupid has some ideas on the best and worst ways to respond:
