Calvin Harris





Adam Richard Wiles, also known as Calvin Harris, is a Scottish DJ, record producer, singer and songwriter. Harris made his debut in 2007 with his album *I Created Disco*. Since then, Harris has collaborated with a number of big-name artists to create hits like, We Found Love with Rihanna, *I Need Your Love* with Ellie Goulding and *Let's Go* with Ne-Yo.

Harris currently holds the UK Singles Chart record for the most top 10 songs from one studio album, with nine top 10 entries, surpassing Michael Jackson. In October 2014, Harris became the first artist to place three songs simultaneously on *Billboard's* top 10 Dance/Electronic Songs chart. He is also the first British solo artist to reach more than one billion streams on Spotify. Aside from winning a number of awards for his hit music, Harris topped the *Forbes*⁴ list for the world's highest-paid DJ from 2013 to 2015.
