Clare Crawley, who is currently coupled with Zack Kalter (a contestant from Desiree Hartsock's season of *The Bachelorette*), lashed back at Frazier after finding out that the Houston fashionista was bad-mouthing Crawley to her man. While sharing a hammock, Frazier dished to Kalter about Crawley's rumored sexual rendezvous with Juan Pablo Galavis (from *The Bachelor* Season 18, when Crawley finished as the runner-up) and called her "cuckoo" in an effort to change Kalter's mind about his budding relationship and love with Crawley.
