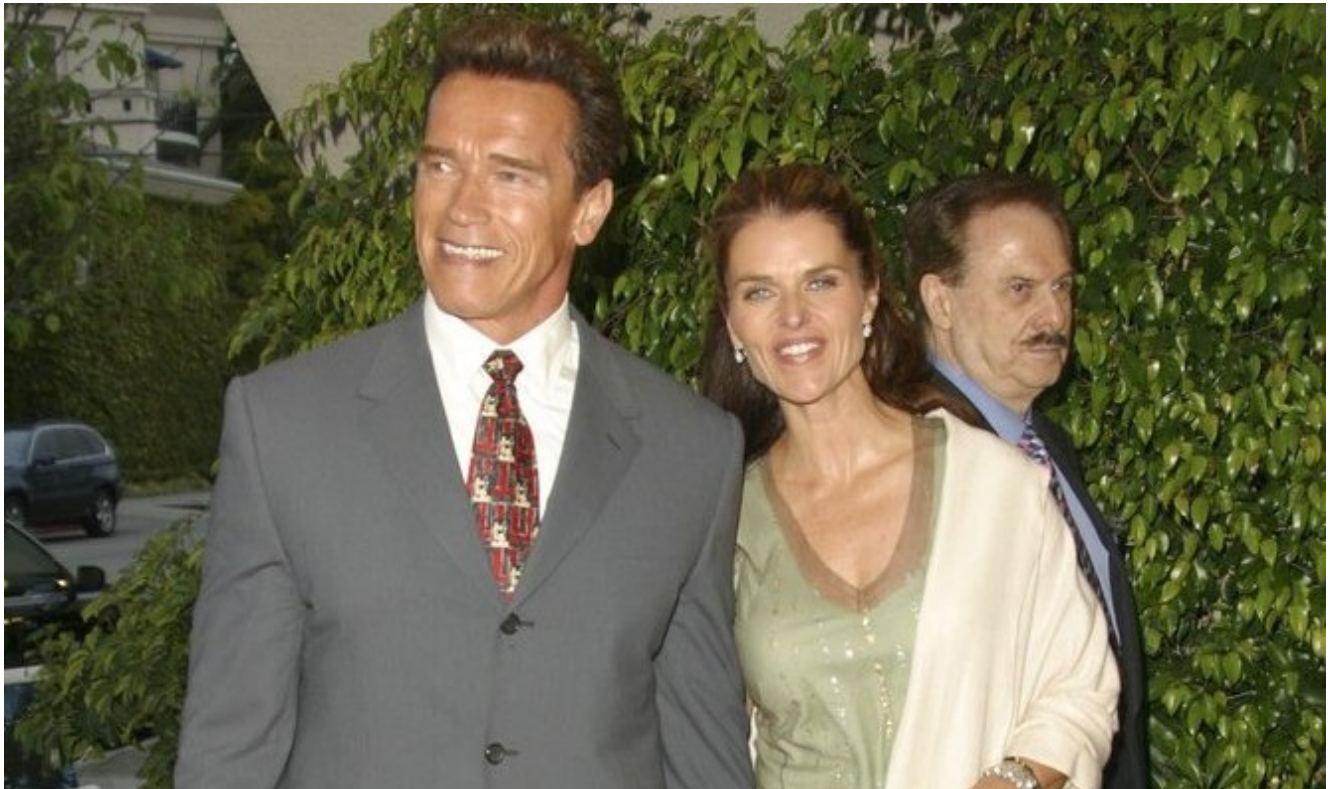

some inscents,or even a few candles. Now tell me that doesn't sound like a story book ending!

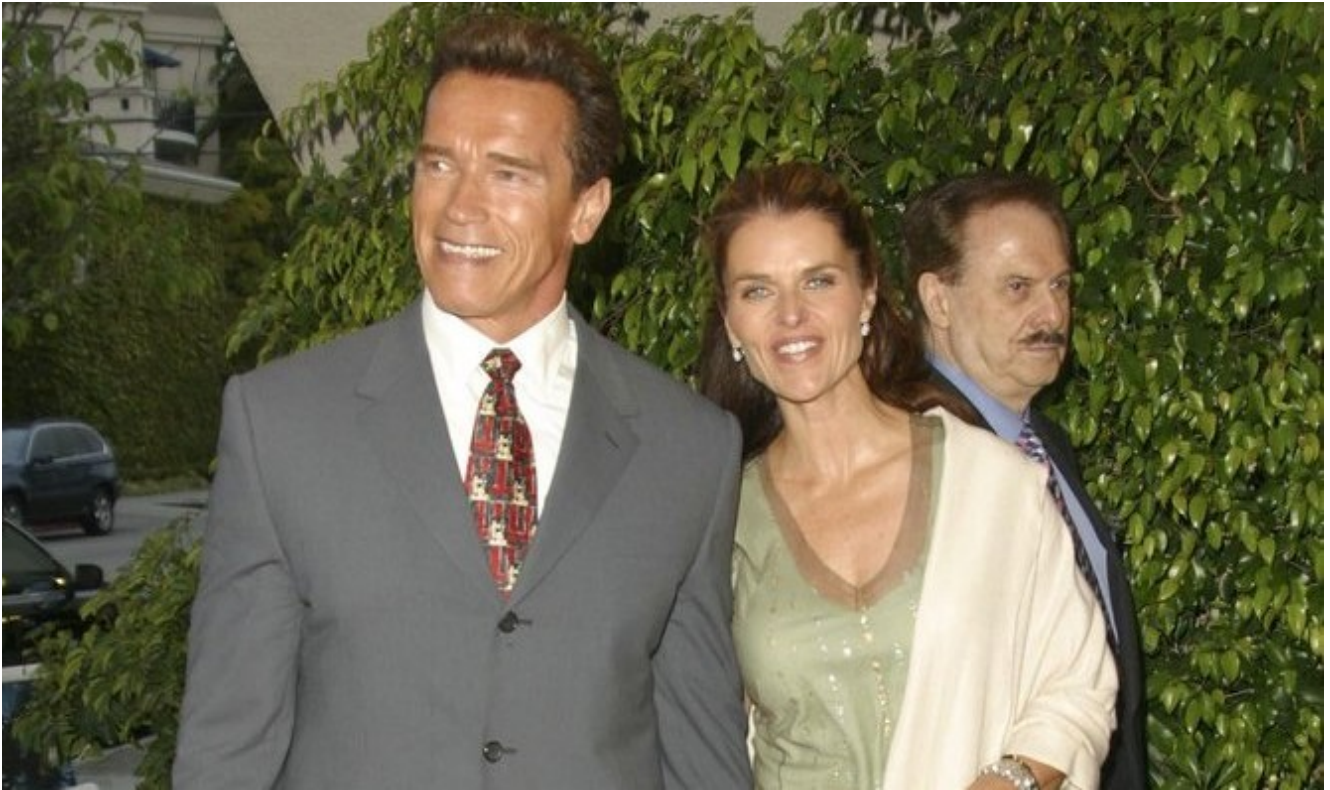

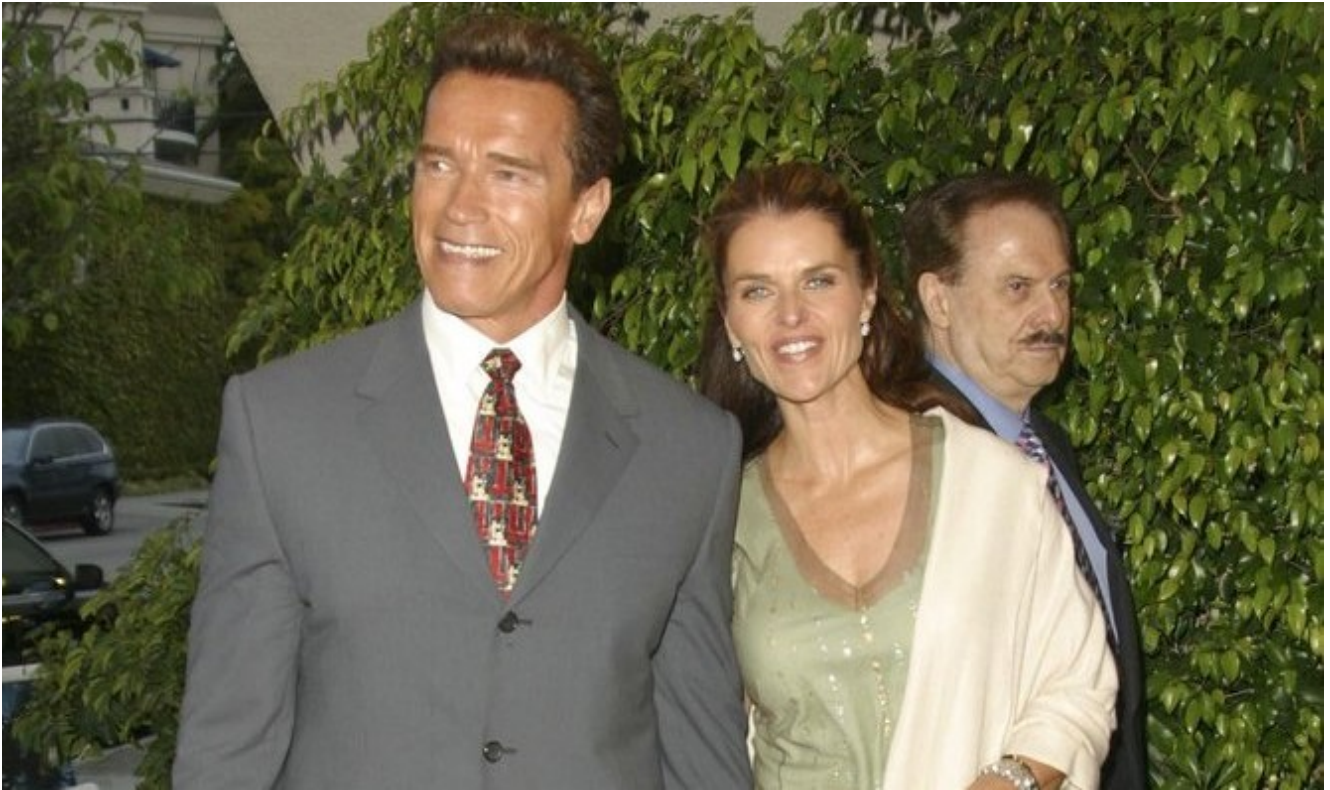

2. Be mindful: Check your surroundings at all times and keep in mind that people watch the way you and your significant

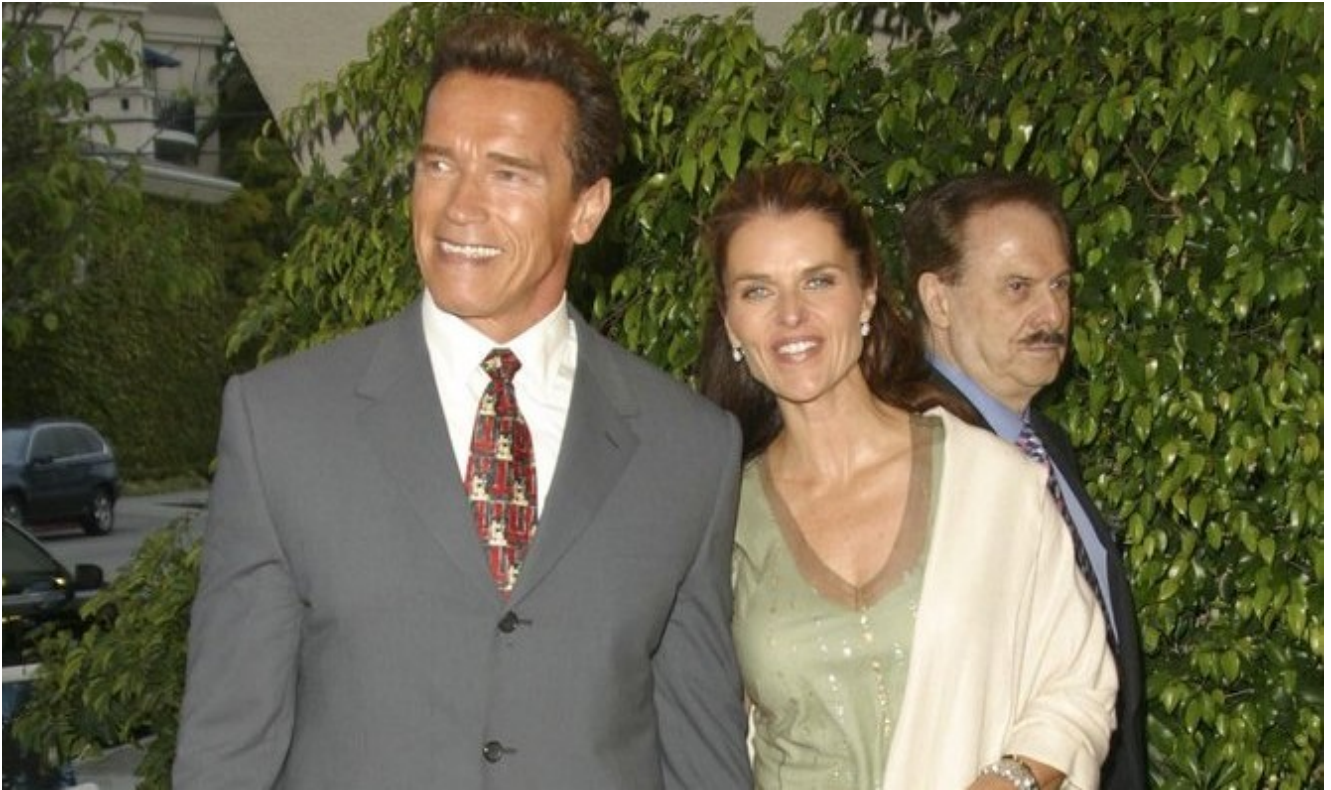
other interact with each other. If you can't keep the competition friendly, people will automatically assume there's some tension or jealousy going on in your relationship.

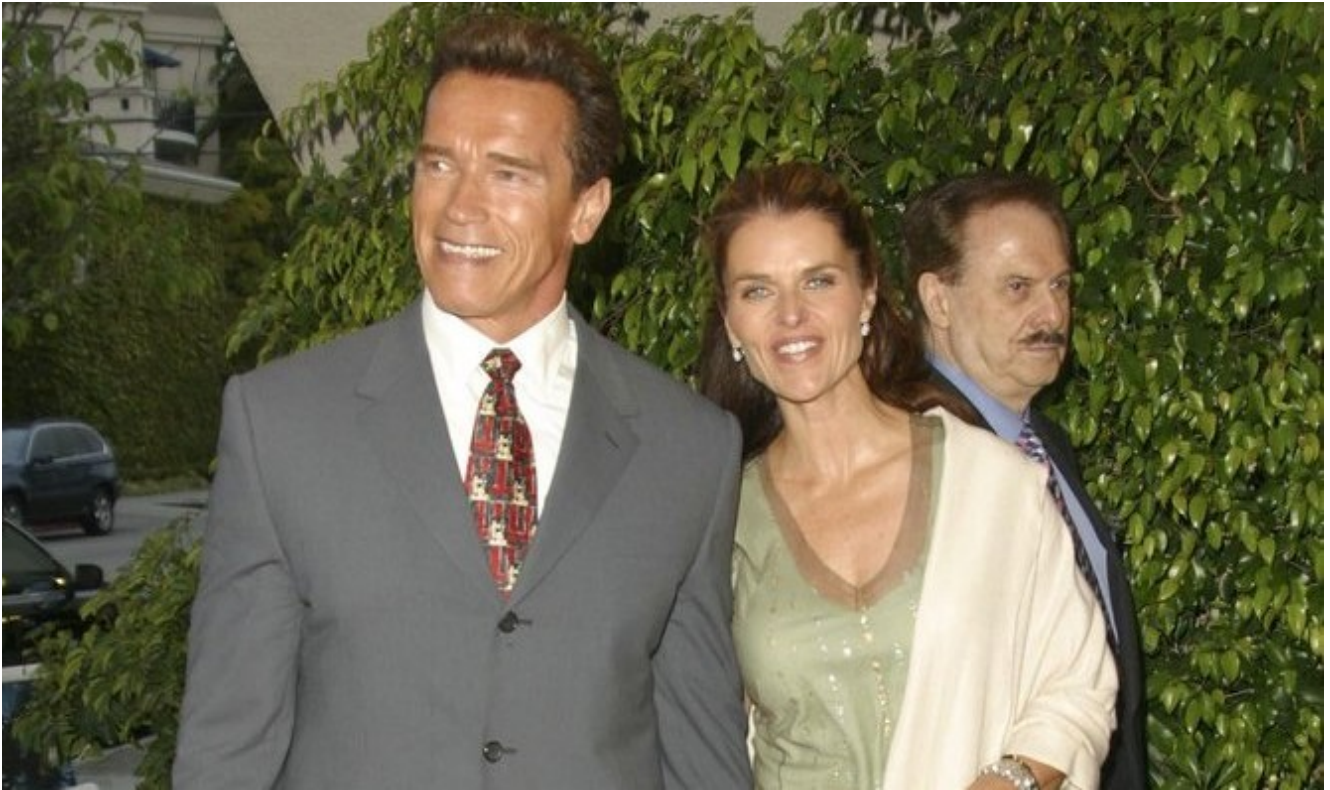

1. Take a trip: If you take some time off and go somewhere new, your perspective on things might change. Traveling will give you time to think and reevaluate your life.

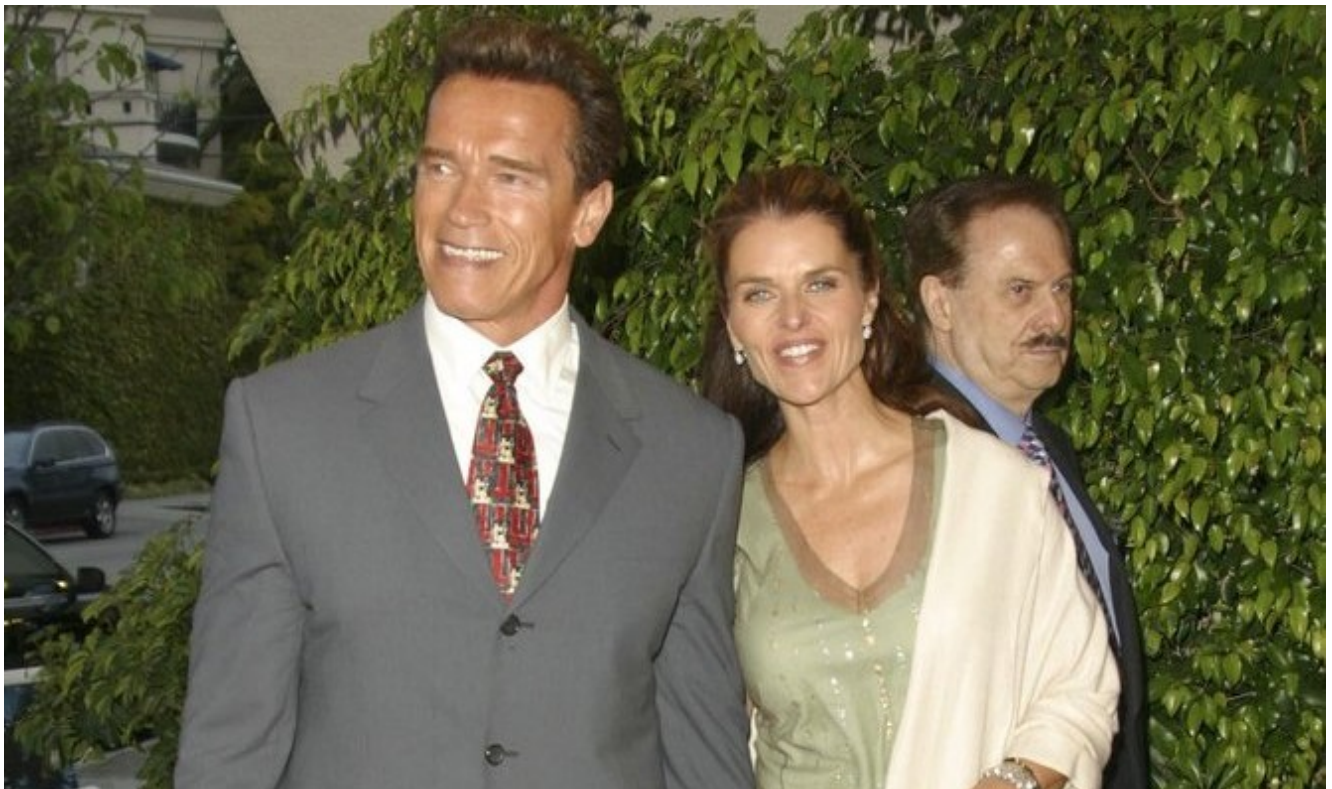

However, Hugh had been living the same lifestyle for a long time prior to meeting Crystal. She knew his style before getting married, but chose to ignore it until the last possible moment.

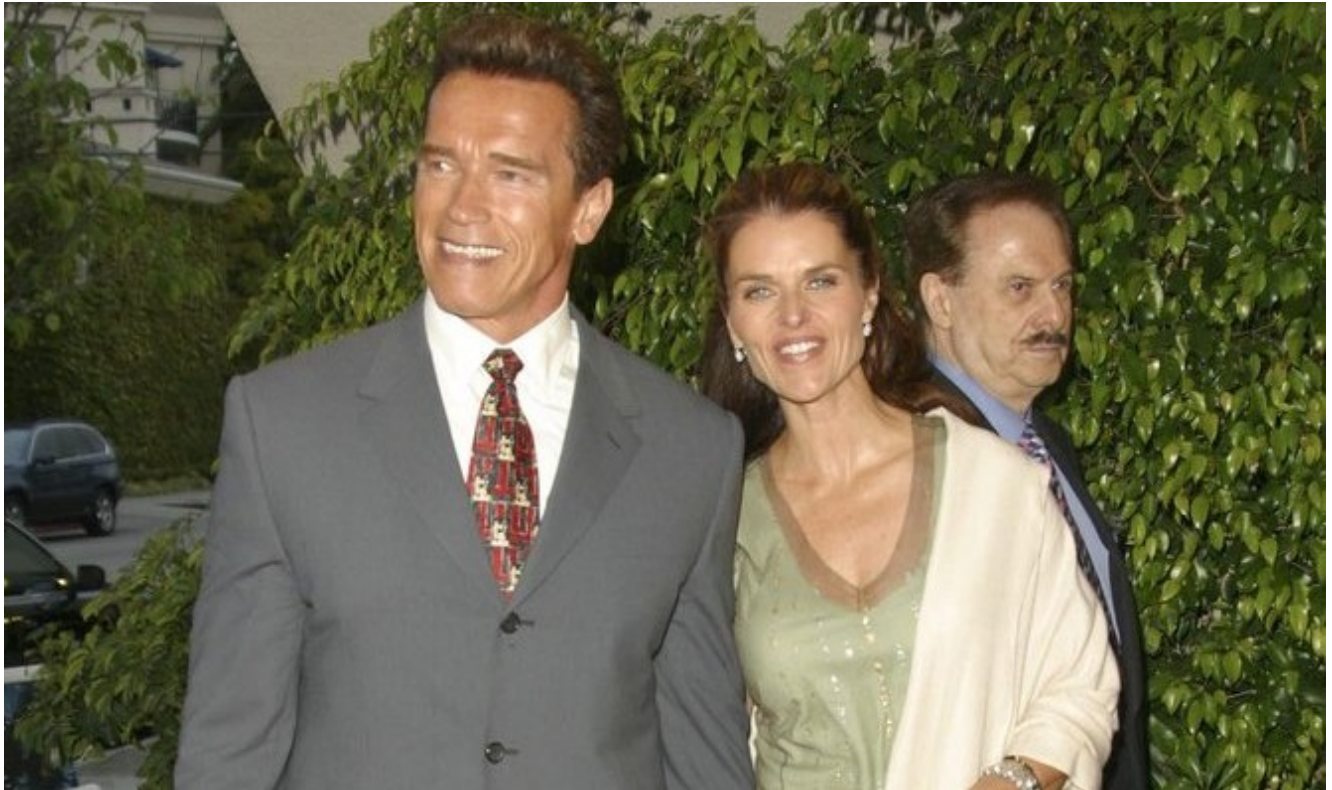
When Life Gives You Lemons, Find A New Date

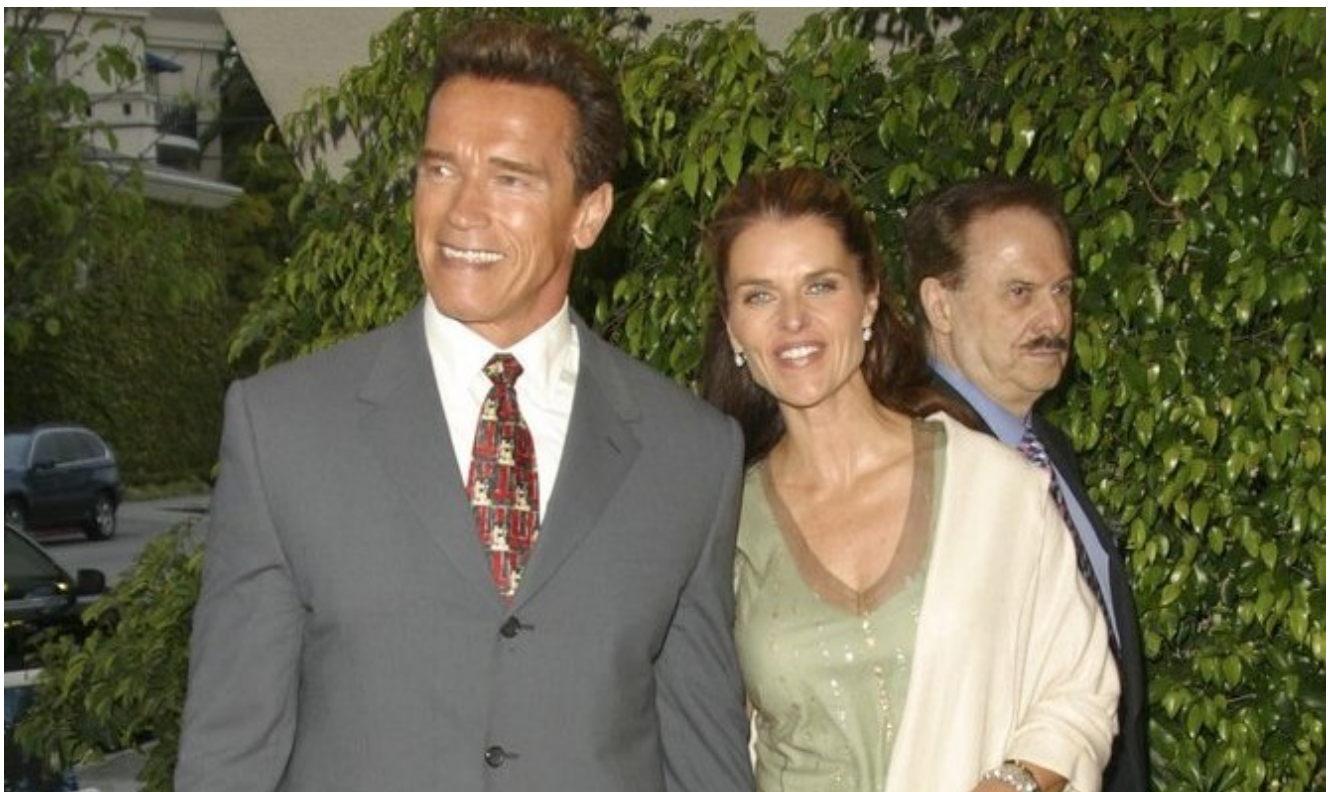

Just because your close relationship came to an end, it doesn't mean that you can never date again. Here's how you can decide if you're ready to re-enter the dating world without rebounding:

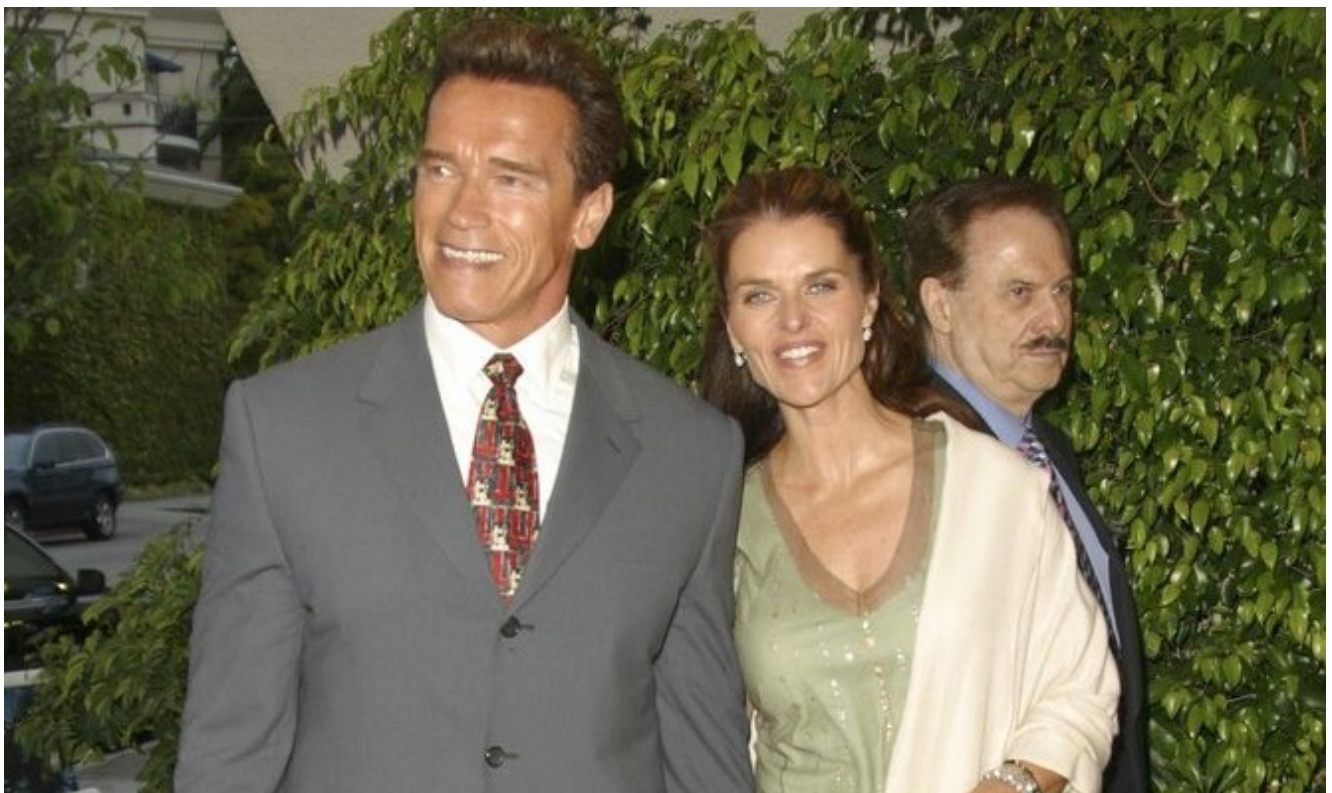

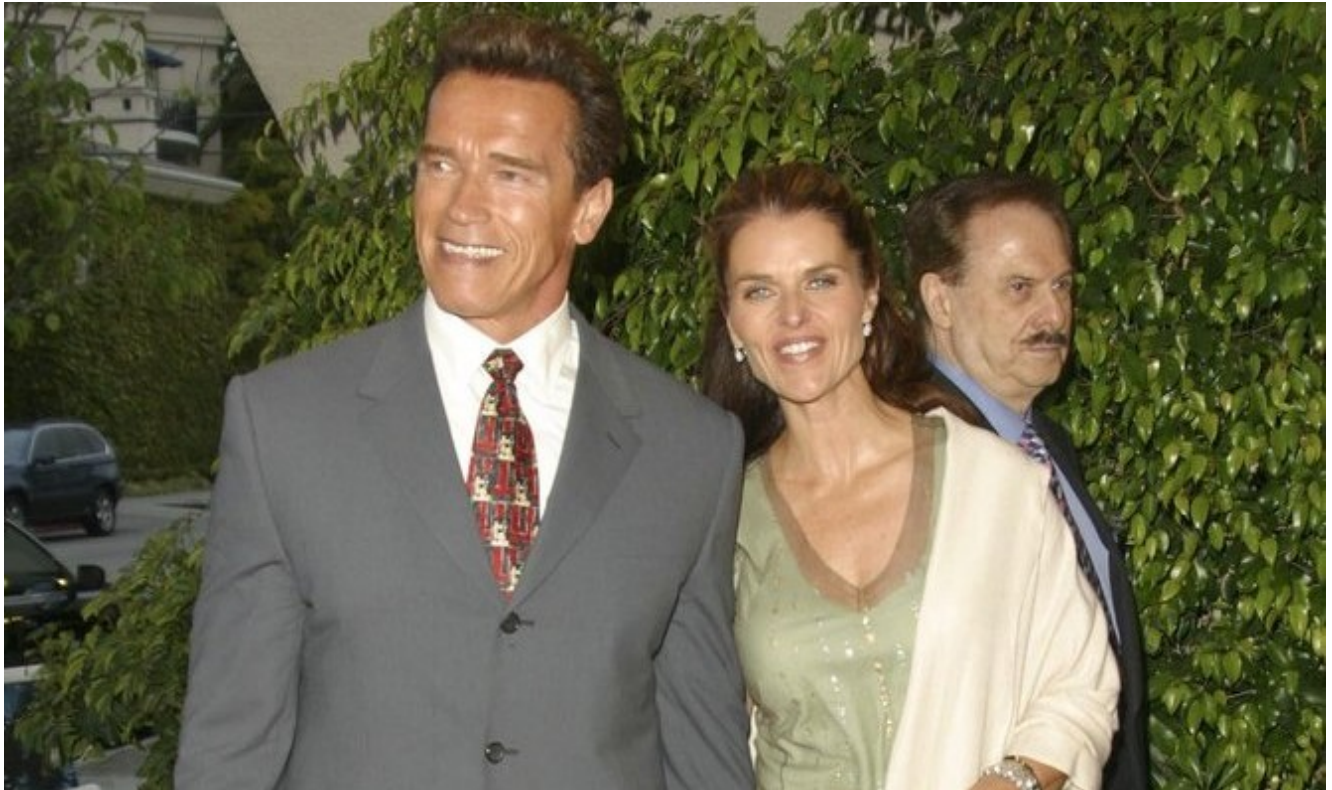
2. Shrug it off: Don't take anything too personally. Nine times out of 10, your partner will have to speak at length to other people on the job. Keep the jealousy at bay.

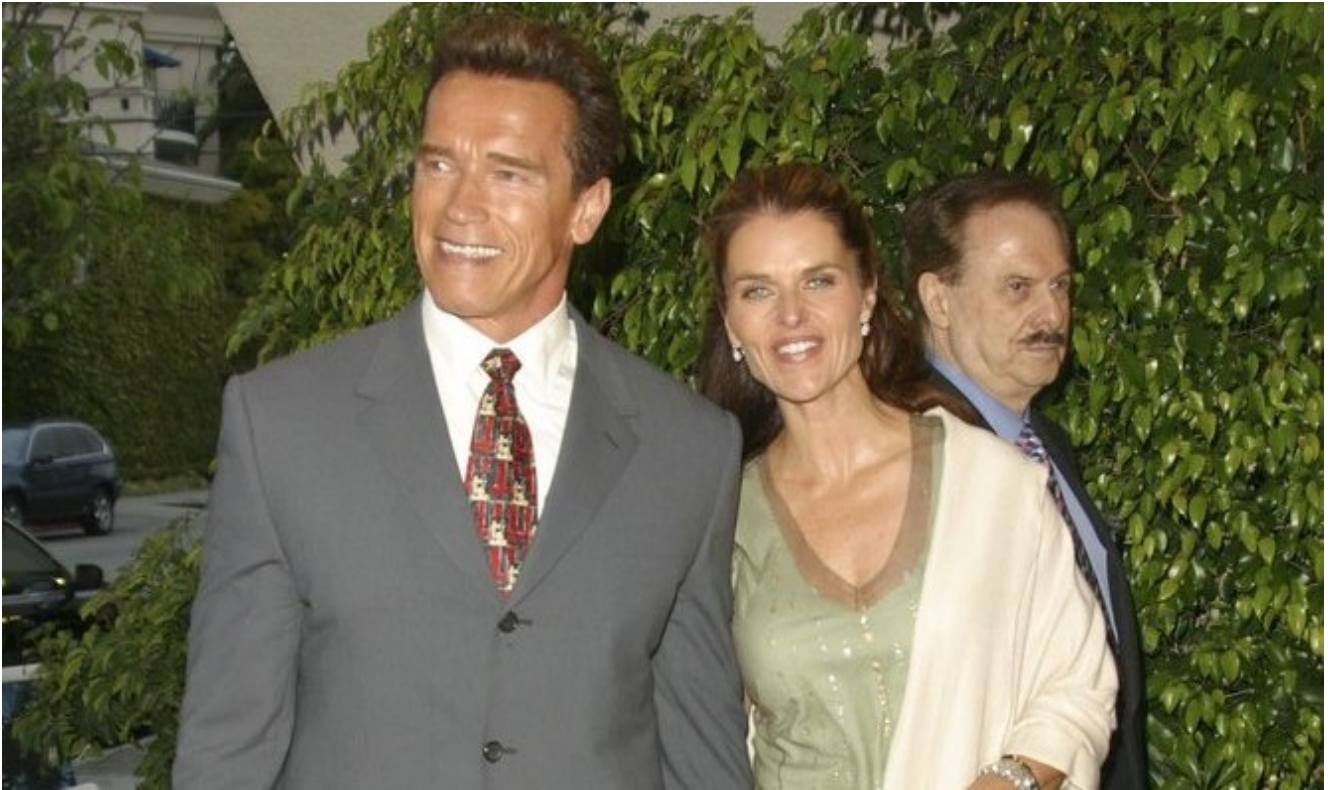

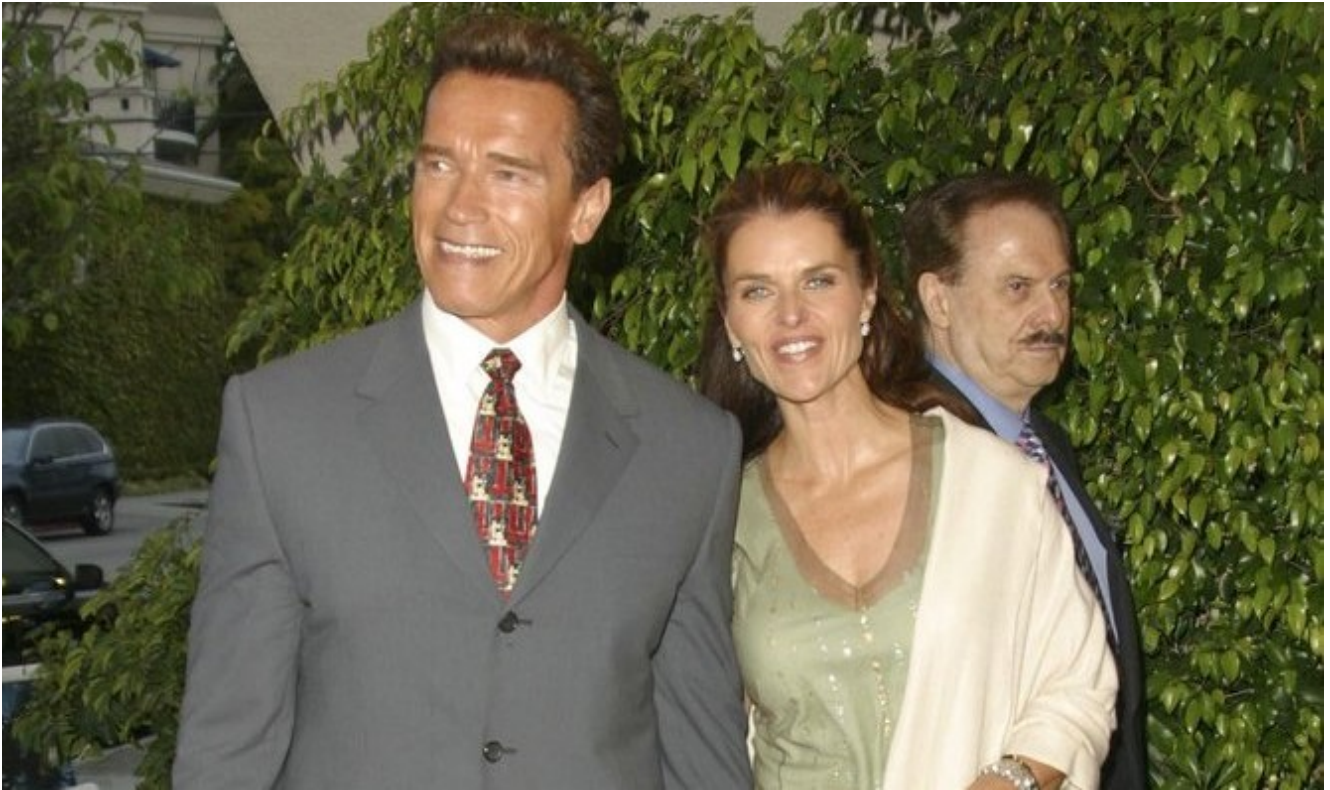
2. Keep the friendship: If you and your ex started off as friends before dating, you may want to maintain that original relationship. Friendship is something you can always fall back on for support.

decisions.

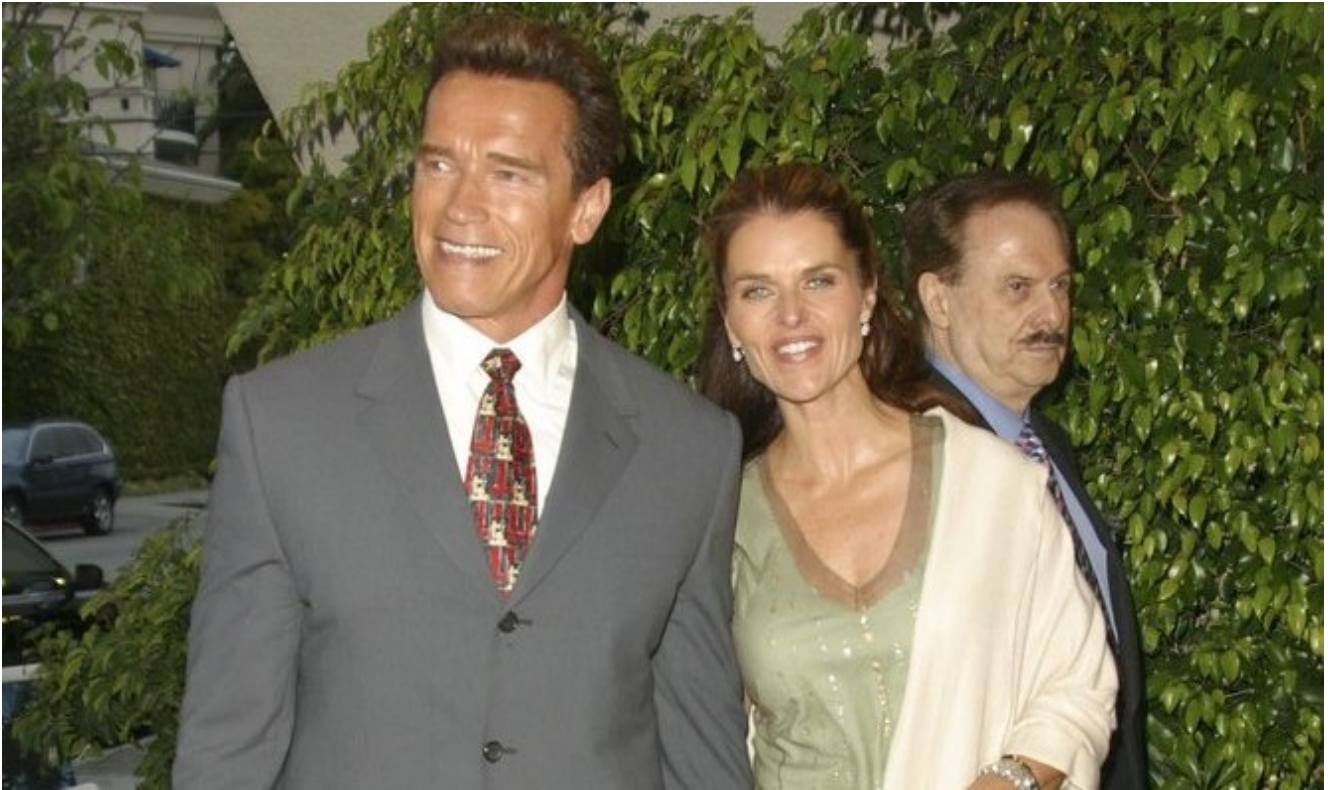

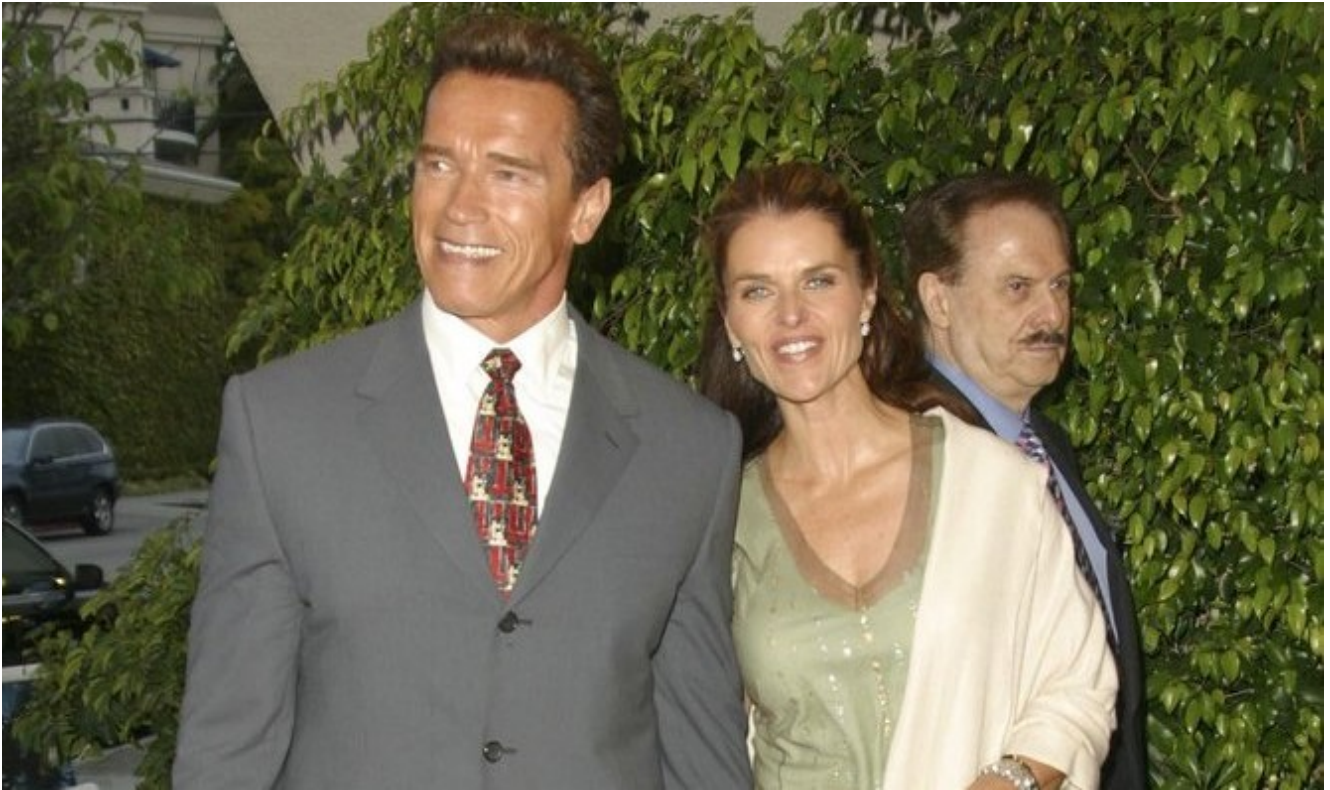

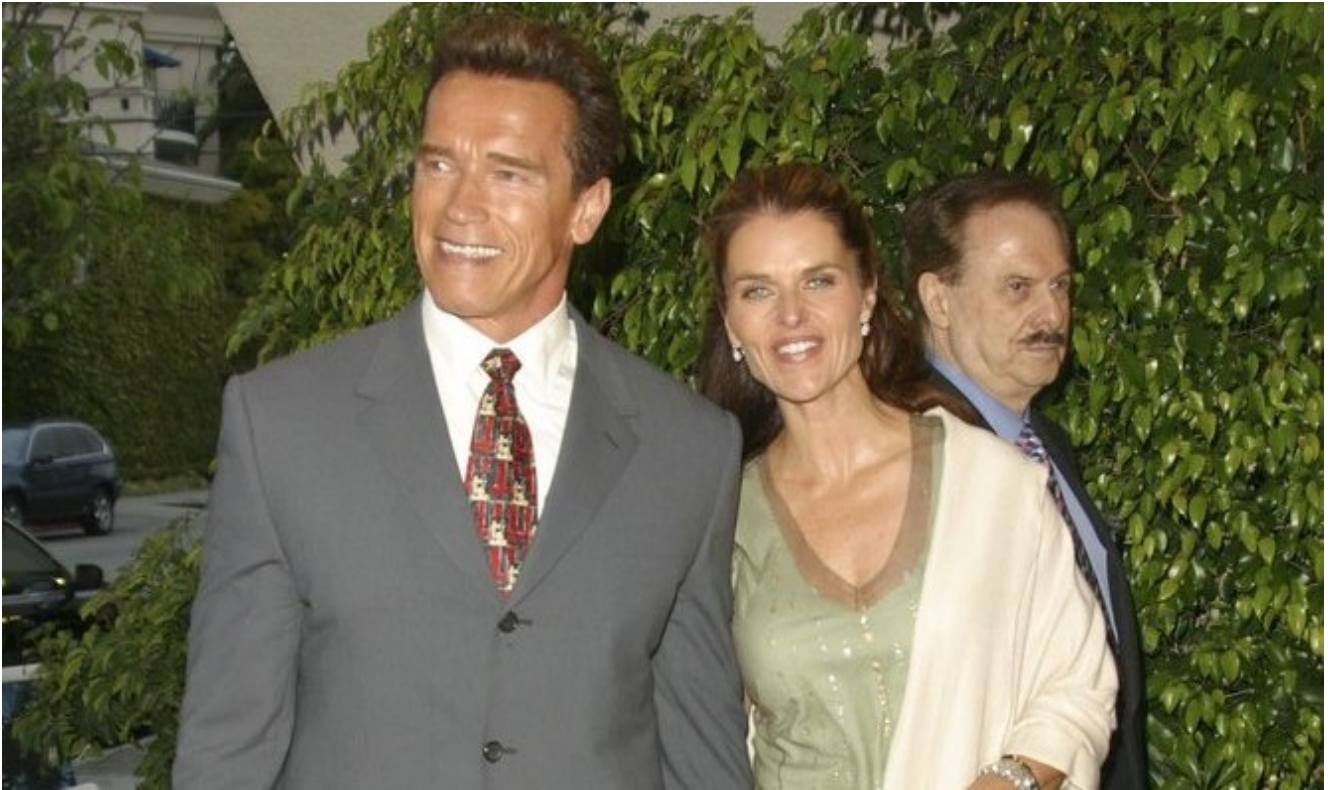

or she has made a mistake without trying to cover it up. If your partner does this, then that's a good sign.

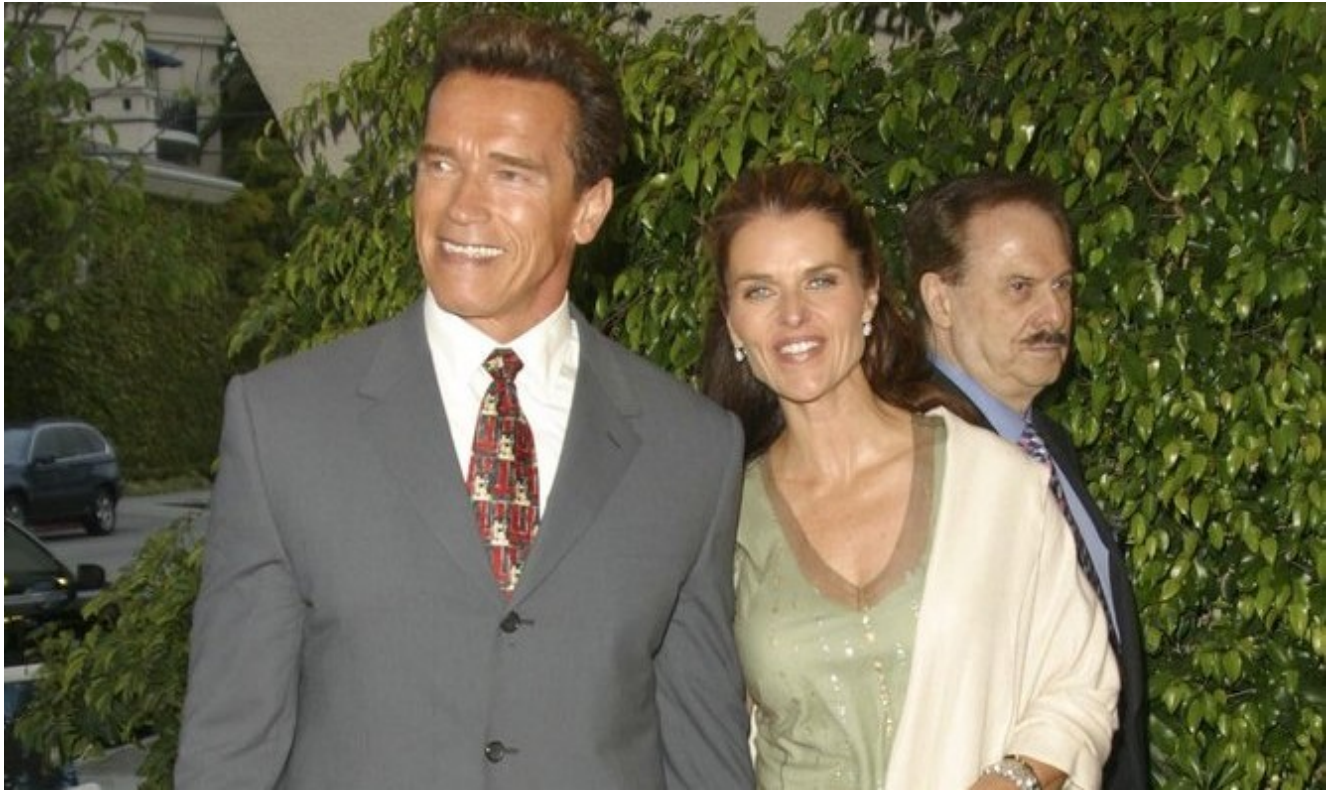

step.

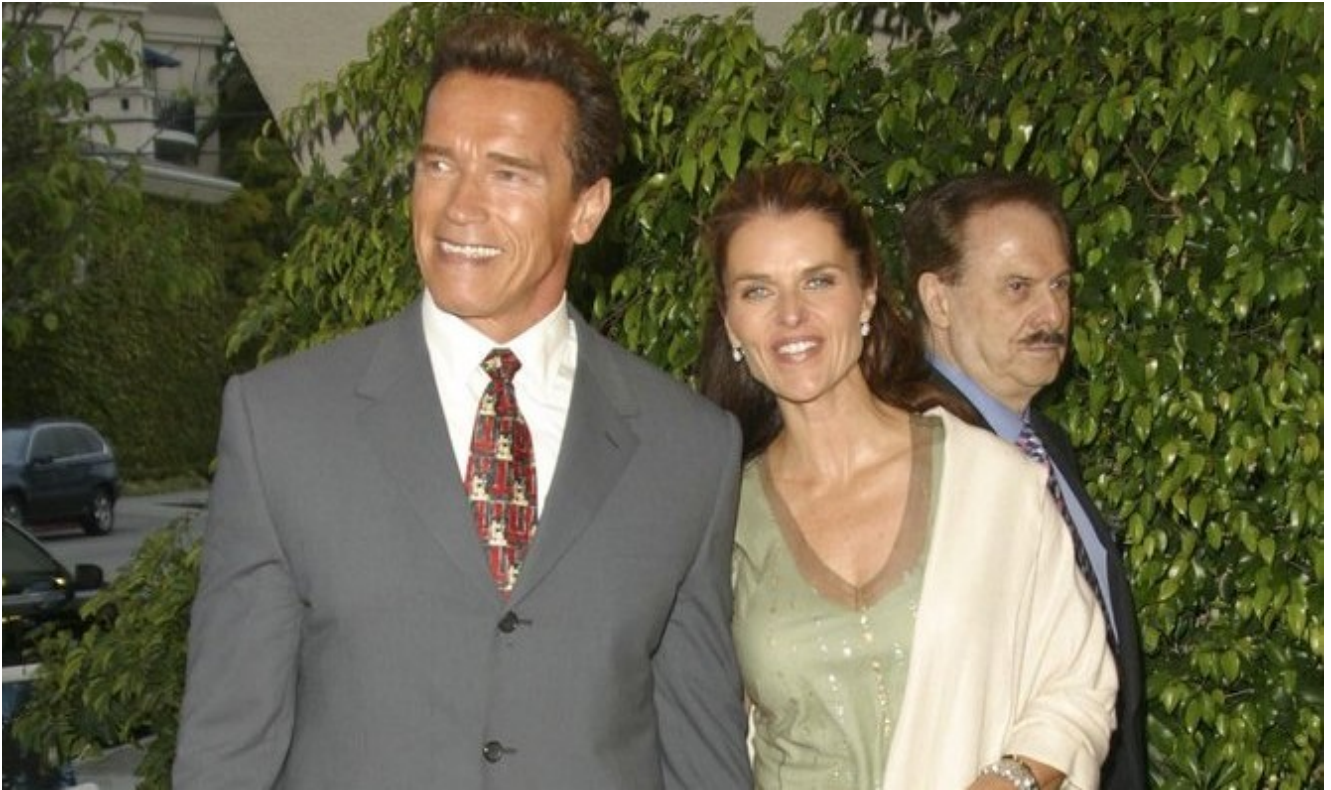

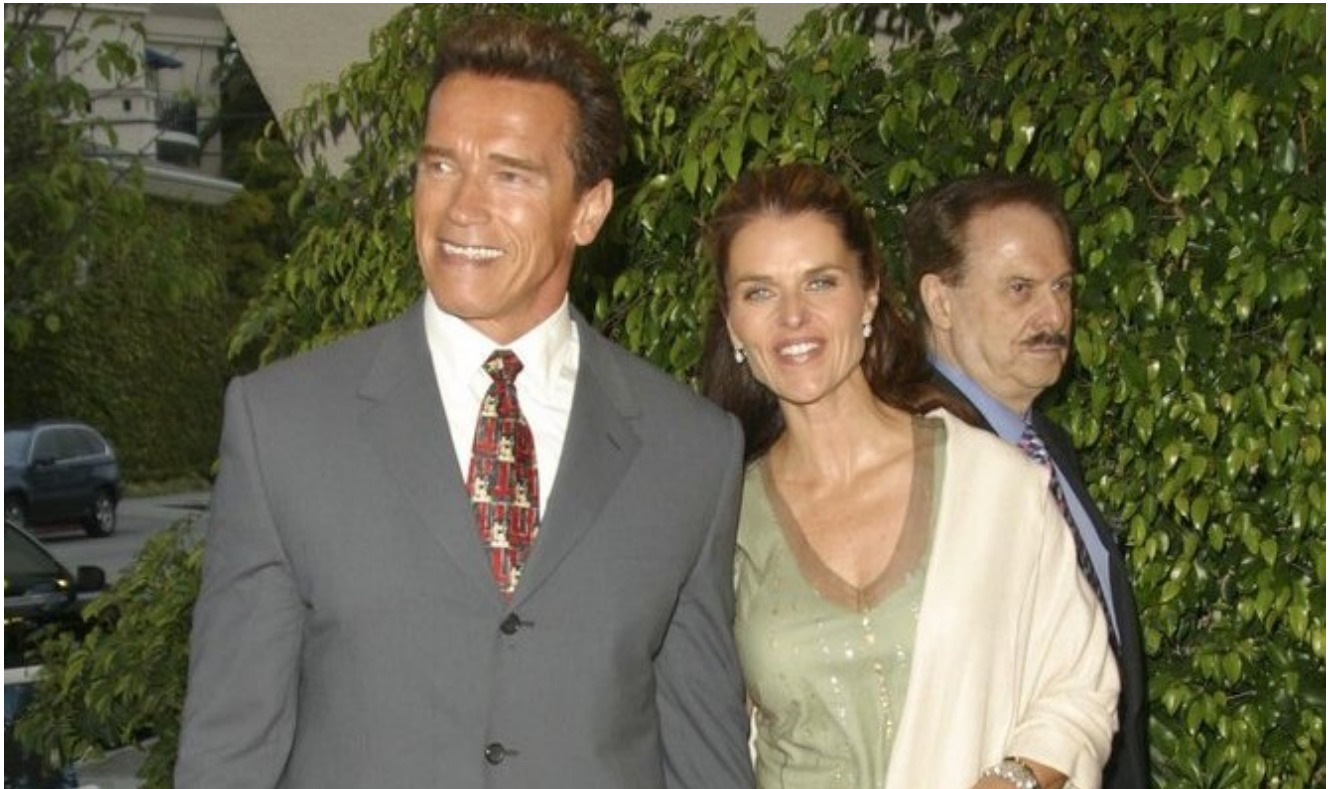
