
While most brides want to plan every aspect of their weddings, the honeymoon is often beyond their control. Here are a few reasons why the bride should not know of her destination:

Easing into married life can be tough sometimes. Cupid has some tips on how to keep the honeymoon phase alive after your romantic vacation ends:



Where are the best places to go for a honeymoon? Cupid's Advice:


Although most of us don't have the luxury of taking our pick of anywhere in the world for our honeymoon, there are a few classic choices:

While you may be ready to relax, don't kick your heels up just yet. Preparation, along with a great attitude, can ensure an unforgettable honeymoon once you've reached your destination.


