One relationship that the budding fan-favorite does gush about, though, is that with Tyra Banks. Of the show's host, Kim raves, "Tyra can back up all the hype around her. The aura I felt while standing in front of her is just *real*. It was amazing...She's so genuine. Off-camera she would come and make sure we were doing okay."

Bachelorette sometime act in ways that make our jaws drop in disbelief. Although we say we would never do half the things we see on television, we shouldn't be so quick to judge: Kelly explains that people often undergo a psychological change when placed in front of a camera. "It was pretty fascinating because, before I auditioned for the show, I was taking a psychology class. I had become friends with a reality TV person, and she told me all these things, and I was flabbergasted," he says. "So I rewrote my thesis paper to show how reality TV shows would be illegal if they were done in psychological experiments. All you have to do is throw cameras at people, and they pretty much do anything. I was really happy when the show came around because it was exactly what I was talking about."

Although having cameras present makes people act a little differently, a big part of why reality TV shows are full of so much drama is the manipulation by the producers and directors. *UnREAL* showcases just how much deceit is put into making a show a hit. It may seem a bit overboard, but the 33-year-old actor insists that it's true. "*UnREAL* is exaggerated to tell the storyline with the characters, but as far as what goes on, from what I've heard, it's not exaggerated at all," the actor says. "If anything, it's almost held back and toned down."

Jeremy, Kelly's character, is the cameraman and a past lover of one of the producers, Rachel, played by Shiri Appleby. Although the two have a complicated past, fans can't help but hope they end up back together. "If you want to be with someone and it's not working out, then you have to ask yourself if you should be with them," he says. "I guess that's the question for most exes. With Jeremy and Rachel, I don't know. I think they both want it to work out, but they've both done some bad stuff."

Without giving too much away, he does hint that more is going

to happen between the exes. "It gets crazier and crazier," the One Life to Live star adds. "Jeremy and Rachel try to deal with their issues."

While Jeremy may be struggling with a lingering old relationship and love, Kelly knows how to deal with an ex. His relationship advice is to be honest with your former flame and with your new partner. "Don't try to hide anything, and don't try to keep either side a secret," he says.

He also shares a piece of love advice for current couples: "If you're really in love, try and love the person more than you think they love you. As long as they're doing that as well, then you guys are good."

Finding Love on Reality TV

Even though it's clear that what happens on reality TV isn't always authentic, that doesn't mean dating shows can't be successful. Still, regardless of cameras, "finding love is the hardest thing to do," Kelly believes. He also points out that shows like *Married at First Sight* have helped people find their soul mate. "Doug Hehner and Jamie Otis – they're still making it. They're one of the reality show couples that my girlfriend and I have become friends with, and they're very happy," he shares.

A big departure from his role on UnREAL, with parts in films like Transformers: Revenge of the Fallen and Jarhead 2: Field of Fire, Kelly is no stranger to being in war-style movies. Ironically, he has a military background and admits that being a past solider and then playing one on set can be a bit aggravating. "A lot of people have a preconceived notion of who soldiers are and why they act like they do," he says. "They think of them as mechanical and not human. On television, they're often supposed to be like robots."

"It can be very constricting if you're an actor and you're trying to play the character, and the writers and producers are like, 'Well, you know, soldiers don't really get nervous,'" he elaborates. "We do. I can promise you that." Although at times frustrating, "it's also really fun to get back in the uniform and play."

With that thought in mind, his latest project is a short film entitled *Prisoner of War*, which was directed by a friend and fellow Army Ranger, Matthew Sanders. "It's probably the most intense role I've ever played," the actor admits. The storyline involves solider suicide and post-traumatic stress disorder, which he feels are "really important" topics.

Whether his character is a solider in battlefield or a cameraman for a reality TV show, Kelly thanks his military background for influencing his acting. "It has helped me in many, many ways," he shares. "I learned a lot about hard work, and I'm really happy for it."

She explains the importance of a diverse representation in the TV world by saying, "You've just got to keep working at diversity. I do think that many networks are trying to get there. *American Crime* is such a diverse show, and ABC as a network has such a diverse roster."

She then adds, "It's also not just about being in front of the camera. It's important for people to want to be *behind* the camera directing and writing these roles. With all of that being said, I don't think I work any less than other actresses. I've been very fortunate, and half of the roles I have booked have not been race specific. I still believe that talent and authenticity win in a room."

As far as the behind-the scenes work goes, the *Desperate Housewives* veteran explains that women are often times harder on her, but she describes that as "a joyful challenge" because, all-in-all, they understand each other.

Yeo is currently working on transforming her one-woman show, Laughing With My Mouth Wide Open, into a screenplay. The show details the true story of her journey from abuse and suppression to freedom and happiness, and her goal is to connect with her audience through art. "I feel that, often times, when you expose yourself, people are actually very accepting because everybody has their own shame about things," the actress-turned-producer explains. "I really wanted to impact younger women. I had a lot of women come up to me, and while none were very vocal, I think they were like, 'Wow, I learned something.'"

She continues, "I wanted to prevent people from getting into situations where they feel compromised. Whenever people are victimized in certain ways, they always wonder, 'Did I cause it?' But I don't feel that's the case."

Although there was a time when her parents disagreed with her career choice, Yeo changed their minds when she realized that acting gave her a sense of wholeness. "In any family, you want stability for your children. When we came over to the states, my dad was making twenty to thirty thousand a year, and my mom sold sewing machines at five dollars an hour. All the while, they were putting us through Catholic school. They were doing their best, so I felt indebted to them," she candidly shares in our exclusive celebrity interview. "Eventually, though, they came around completely. When I found a sense of selfesteem through acting, they had to respect it."

Of her desire to act, she reasons, "Some people choose the art of creativity because it makes them process things and it makes them more stable people. There's nothing more important than emotional health."

Celebrity Interview with Founders of 'Reality TV Awards': "We're Not Going to Hide Anything!"

On any given day of the week, millions of people sit down on their couches with some good snacks, and tune into their favorite <u>reality TV</u> shows. But what many people might not know is the amount of hard work and dedication that goes into the production of each show. Whether it's *Keeping Up with the Kardashians, American Idol,* or *The Bachelor,* massive teams of people put in hundreds of man hours every week to make these shows possible – and the cast and crew of these shows will be honored at the 3rd annual *Reality TV Awards* on May 13. In this celebrity interview, the founders of these awards, Kristen Moss and Andrew Ward, discuss the production of the award show, who we can expect to see, and the future of reality TV.

Reality TV Awards Founders Discuss Awards Show Process

As it approaches its third year, plans for The Reality TV Awards are bigger than ever. Moss and Ward, the founders and executive producers of these awards say that there is a lot to expect in terms of number of guests and a few other surprises.

"This year we're going to have over 700 attendees." Says Ward. "The first year we had about four or five hundred, so it's grown a lot. We even have the cast of *Dance Moms* coming and the full cast of *Deadliest Catch*. It's really exciting to see the variation of cast members that are coming to this because all of your favorite reality TV shows in one room is almost like a reality TV show in itself!"

Moss adds that in addition to reality television stars, a great number of networks and production companies will be in attendance that night. "Essentially how we start out is we call production companies and networks, and we have them submit their shows to the categories." She says. "So as we've grown, we've seen the support of each of those production companies and networks, which is really important to us. We're inviting all of them to come this year to show how it [the awards] benefits their shows, their company, the networks, and how their fans are really supportive of them."

Another development in this year's awards is the increase of fan involvement. This year marks the first time when fans can attend the award show as well as stream it live online. The venue for the show is the Avalon Hotel in Beverly Hills, which Ward says makes this possible. "The great thing about this year is being in a bigger venue, so we added a fan section. We have a very limited amount of tickets on sale to the public, but this gives the public a chance to see what's actually inside the show, which has never been done before."

In addition, Ward says the live stream of the awards will not only give fans a chance to feel like they're guests, but also to get a backstage look of the event. "It's going to be the nitty gritty, we're not going to hide anything, and we know that people love to see everything there is to do backstage."

Moss and Ward are two people who know the world of reality television very well, especially how much work goes into the production of a TV show. Although audiences only get to view the final product, they reveal that there are hundreds of people working to make things run smoothly.

"I worked on *Master Chef* for a couple seasons," says Ward, "and a lot of people don't realize that you have 150 crew members working behind [the scenes.] There's actually so many people that it takes to film a given episode, which is why we do these awards. It's recognizing the talent on screen, but also the entire team of people that work behind them."

Moss says that for this reason, her favorite award show category is "Bad Ass Crew," which honors the behind-the-scenes crew of reality TV. "It really gives a nod to the production crew who has to endure the hours and temperatures of whatever world they're put into. A lot of time when people are watching these shows, they don't think about the guy who's capturing these moments. But there is somebody out there capturing the moments and putting their own life in danger, whether they get recognized or not."

After being in the reality television industry, Moss says that the new trend for future shows will be "risk" based shows, specifically in the realm of dating shows. She discusses that the show *Married at First Sight* falls into this category. "I think what it is with *Married at First Sight* is, it's a wedding, but what's going to be so shocking at this wedding is that these people are meeting for the first time."

Ward adds that the show has a huge fan-base who are extremely active on social media. "There are a lot of fan groups for it, and we follow them. I saw a post today that people wanted to know how the couples from season 1 are doing because it's such a faux pas concept, and that's what reality TV really is. They want to see if something like that can actually work."

When asked about the future of reality show concepts, the pair said that creators will never run out of original ideas. "Any time I think they're going to run out of ideas, somebody approaches us or with a new idea, even if it's a game show, that I had no idea could be possible." Says Ward.

Transgender Facial Surgeon Discusses Celebrity News Surrounding Bruce Jenner

Since <u>Bruce Jenner's</u> celebrity interview with Diane Sawyer aired on Friday, April 24, the world has been *Keeping Up with Bruce*.

Jenner's gender transition and bombshell interview has been making celebrity news since it aired. During his conversation he stated that he has been slowly transitioning since the early '80s but never felt completely comfortable to go through with it until now.

At 65-years-old the star of *Keeping Up with the Kardashians* says he is now "relieved and happy about moving forward and going public about his transition." Jenner also said that he is on a mission to help others in the transgender community who are facing discrimination. In our recent <u>celebrity</u> <u>interview</u> with Dr. Jeffrey Spiegel, a world renowned facial plastic surgeon specializing in facial feminization surgery, we were able to gather some great insight.

Transgender Facial Surgeon Comments on Bruce Jenner's Celebrity News

Facial Feminization Surgery (FFS) is defined as a group of surgical procedures that alter the face to increase its femininity. In addition to FFS, Dr. Spiegel specializes in advanced facial aesthetics for both male and female patients. His patients come to him from around the world in order to complete the final, and most important step in the process. "A lot of people assume that the most important part would be the sexual reassignment surgery or the genital reassignment surgery," explains Dr. Spiegel. "But a transgender woman knows she's a woman. The problem is, that people she meets don't see her that way. I help a person to present to the outside world exactly the way that they feel on the inside," he says.

When talking about Jenner's transgender decision the physician isn't surprised. "Bruce Jenner's story is very consistent with others, especially because transgender men and women know their identity at a very early age." He adds, "While trying to come to grips with these feelings, often those who are transgender will try to pursue something that is extremely manly or extremely macho: becoming a police officer, a firefighter, joining the military." **Related Link:** <u>Kim Kardashian Reacts to Latest Celebrity News</u> of Bruce Jenner's Transition

Transgender men and women often struggle during their lifetimes with how they really feel inside, which is why the age in which a person transitions tends to vary. This could explain why Bruce Jenner is coming forward now in his sixties and addressing this matter. Dr. Spiegel points out that Jenner grew up in an age without the Internet and that could be a good reason why he didn't decide to do anything until now. "As a young child feeling like a woman, there weren't many resources for him to figure out what was going on. Therefore, there was probably a lot of confusion when he was a child due to the fact that he felt like a woman on the inside while still retaining the outward appearance of a man."

Dr. Spiegel also advises that there are a few things that Jenner must consider before taking the next step in his journey. "Bruce needs to decide what choice he's going to make. He needs to decide how he wants to live. If he wants to live as Bruce Jenner, someone people *see* as a man, but one in which he *feels* like a woman, or if he wants to transition and live full time as a woman," explains Dr. Spiegel. If he wants to fully transition, there are a few surgeries that he would need to undergo over a period of time.

Celebrity Interview with Dr. Jeff Spiegel Reveals Family Expectations

Big life events such as the gender transition of a family member can also be difficult for loved ones to handle initially. Dr. Spiegel says, "In general there is a sense of disbelief followed by examination and they look for clues of the behavior of the person that may have manifested over the years." When it comes to the family, Spiegel says family members actually go through a mourning of their loved one. He explains, "If you have a brother who becomes a sister, you lose your brother; your brother goes away. [But] you gain a sister. It's the same person. It's a happier person in many ways and eventually they become a better person because they become whole."

Another topic that people are unsure about is the sexual preference of a transgender person. "A person's sexual preferences and who they are sexually attracted to, doesn't really seem to be predictable when a person transitions. As with any other woman, some transgender women are heterosexual, some are homosexual, some are bisexual," says Dr. Spiegel. There is no real connection to predict which preference an individual may have. In Jenner's case, he told Diane Sawyer in his interview that he is "asexual."

In reference to his profession Dr. Spiegel says, "The most rewarding part of being a plastic surgeon is making people feel whole." He enjoys helping people outwardly look the way that they feel on the inside. "They feel comfortable. It gives them self-esteem, it gives them pride, confidence and improves [their] health."

In terms of what Bruce's Jenner's public announcement means for the future of the transgender community he believes that this will create a greater awareness of the transgender community and that people who face this same challenge will look to Jenner as a role model. "I think Bruce Jenner has a lot of responsibility to the transgender community now and in the future, particularly those who are undergoing a transition process." He concludes, "They will watch how Bruce Jenner handles this and will potentially model their own behavior because of his actions."
