Cupid's Advice:

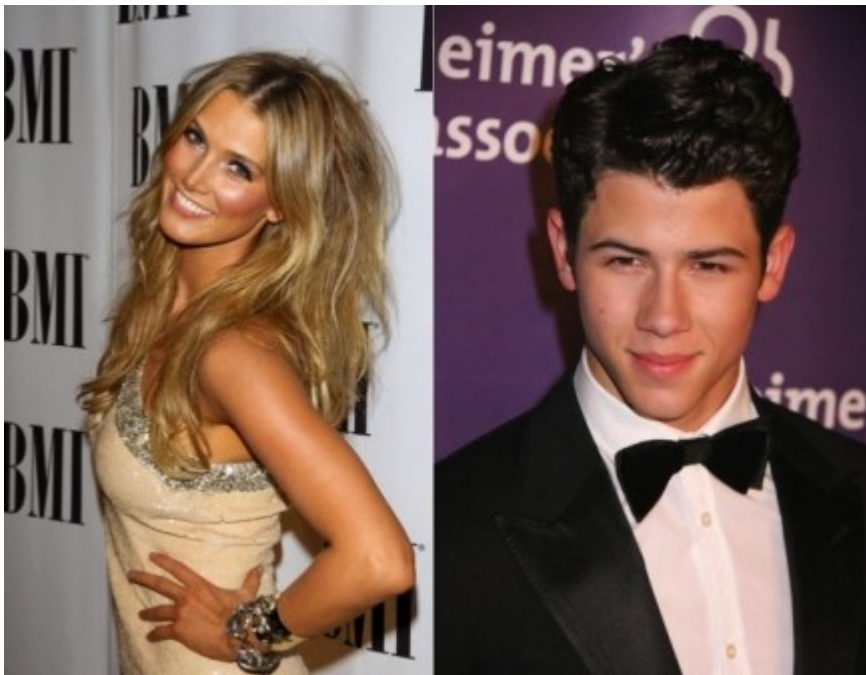
When you're dating someone who already has children, it's extremely important that you make a connection with them. Cupid has some suggestions:

Is it healthy to go on vacation right after a breakup?

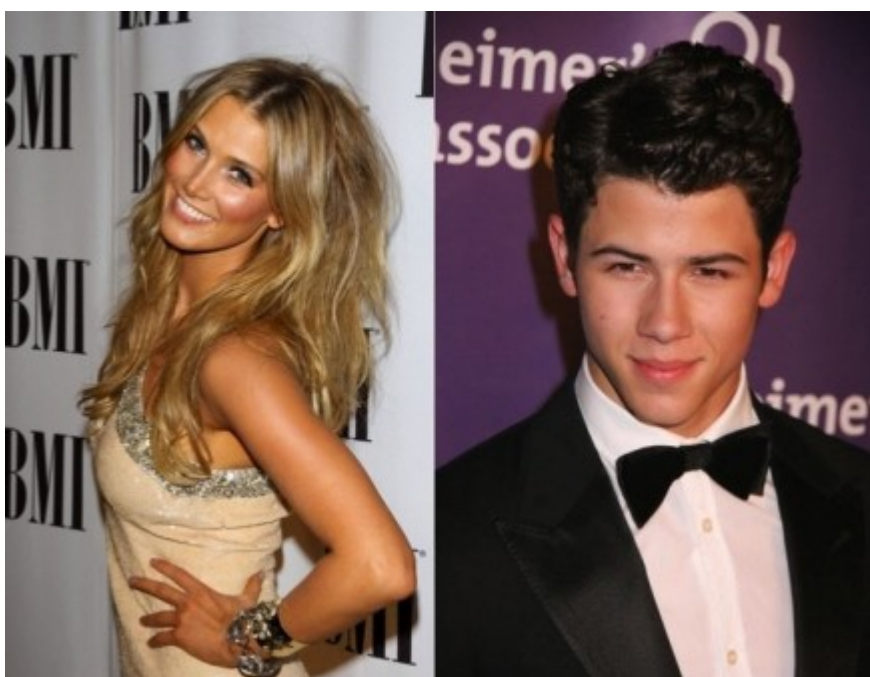
Cupid's Advice:
