
Celebrity News: Taylor Lautner Says Britney Spears Tried to Set Him Up with Her Sister Jamie Lynn


3. The little things are the big things: Pay attention to the



Knowing when it is the right time to get engaged is more than confusing. Not only is it confusing however, it is challenging to determine. Some people say 'when you know, you know' yet,


this is not always the case. You may know, but not entirely know. It really is simply a enormous, confusing process. Cupid has some advice for this:
