
Rob Pattinson and Kristen Stewart Smooch In New York

Cupid's Advice:


Sometimes couples engaging in PDA can make the general public uncomfortable. Here are some guidelines:

How do you make love work with little time?


Cupid's Advice:

Cupid's Advice:


There are perks and downfalls to having either a small or big wedding. It all depends on your preference and your budget:

Cupid's Advice:


The answer is "yes." As the Twilight stars have discovered, double dates, triple dates or even just dates with your

Just because you and your partner aren't on exactly the same path doesn't mean that you can't work it out. Cupid has some tips on how to resolve conflicting career aspirations:


1. Support: No matter what your partner decides to do for


Cupid's Advice:
