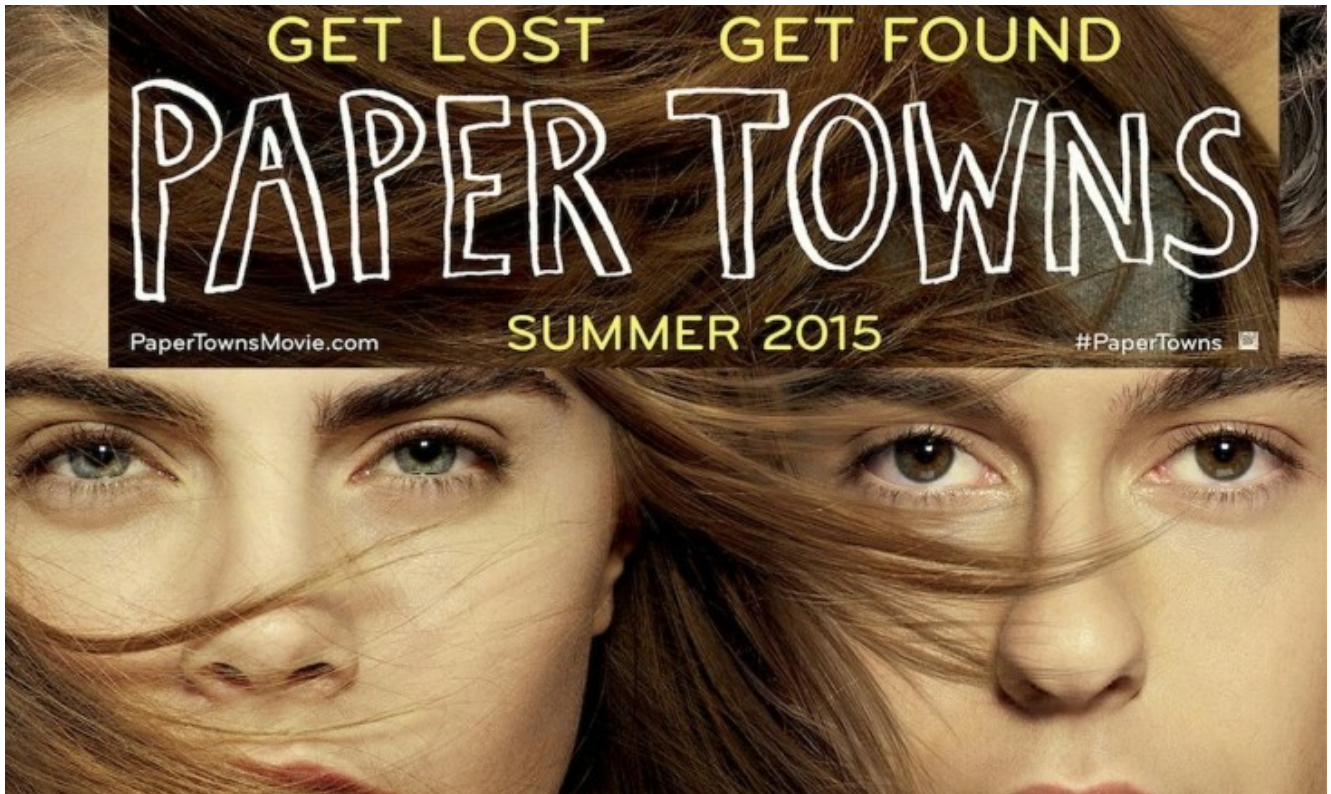


# John Green Chick Flick, 'Paper Towns,' Hits Theaters
