

On Monday night, we were treated to a three-hour season premiere of *Bachelor Pad 2*. These two definitely know the game, so we were interested on their take on the first night of action in "the pad"!

Did it surprise you to see Jake confront Kasey so honestly and directly on the first night? And along those same lines, were you shocked to hear that Jake had so many unresolved feelings regarding Vienna?

David: That was all BS. Jake doesn't have feelings for her. f he really wanted to say those things, there are plenty of ways to get in touch with her besides doing it on national television. Natalie: Jake's only concern is getting back in the good graces of Bachelor fans. He has had so many opportunities to apologize to Vienna. He is always in L.A.! I would like to see a real side of Jake, but that isn't going to happen. He is so concerned with his image that he doesn't care about the game. I guarantee he went on just to clean up the mess he caused last year when their breakup aired. Saying he still loves Vienna? Really, Jake? As far as Vienna is concerned, she is playing the game very well. She isn't falling for his BS and she still wants him out of the house. She isn't being mean; she just knows Jake more than any of us and doesn't trust him at all.

The chemistry between Ames and Jackie was apparent from the first night – but they chose not to partner up for the first

challenge ("Hook Up"). Your thoughts about this strategy?

David: That was funny. The first morning of the show, they are by the pool making out? I like them for each other though. I think they are both awesome. I thought it was a good move not partnering up this early on though. If you think about it, now you not only have each other's backs, but you brought two more people into the equation that have your back as well.

Dave and I worked this strategy in our "Kissing" challenge last season.

Last season and this season, it seems that Gia is always feeling vulnerable going into the rose ceremonies. Why do you think she is always on the verge of being eliminated, and do you think there is a chance she will advance far this season?

David: Gia's problem is she lies to herself and everyone around her. She plays the sweet card but is very vindictive. She did that on our season, too. She asks, "why can't everyone be honest and just get along." Then, she lies to everyone and makes up stories that aren't even true. Wherever she is, drama is not far away, hence the reason she is back It's kind of funny to watch because I for this season. really don't know if she knows she is doing it and actually believes she is not. Jesse Kovacs and I used to laugh so hard listening to her on *Bachelor Pad 1*. It's a terrible strategy and is the reason she is always on the verge of elimination. I like Gia as a person, but some of her bad qualities come out in these situations.

Natalie: I don't think Gia will go very far this season, because she has a huge red flag on her back for already being a competitor last season. Also, Gia always forms a group with the outsiders, and this just doesn't work. The insider group is always the strongest group. They have strong bonds and connections and wouldn't play both sides like an outsider would, for example: Ali and Rated R. Gia should have partnered up with Graham. They were friends before the show and he would be a good partner. Instead she chose Jake who no one really cares for. I don't understand what she was thinking! I wanted her to go far. I love Gia!

Thoughts on this week's eliminated contestants – Rated R and Ali. Why do you think the group chose to get rid of them so quickly? And, with them gone, who do you think is most vulnerable next week?

David: Rated R and Ali got sent home because they were trying to play both sides of the fence and got caught. As in real life, if you do this you will eventually get caught and when you do, not only one side comes down on you but both will and boom — you're sent packing! It's a terrible strategy because people will talk to each other and find out. I think Jackie and Ames have to be careful here. I have not seen them take a side yet and are freelancing around, which can make them an easy target.

Natalie: On my season, Juan left the first night because we caught him making alliances with everyone. Literally He was trying to play both sides like Rated R. evervone! When you play both sides, you are absolutely going to get Rated R should have done his homework. BTW most caught! humiliating limo exit of all time! Made some great TV! Ali seems to be a little ditzy to me. How could she not realize she was on the chopping block when she too was playing both She didn't even try very hard to clean up her mess sides? once she found out she was up for elimination. She isn't cut out for this game at all.

Now, here's Natalie and David's take on what's in store:

Who are you most excited to see in the mansion this season?

Natalie: When David and I were on the show, we had strong, unintentional friendships with several of the cast mates. Bachelor Pad wasn't even in existence when we all became friends with each other; our friendships were pure and innocent. 1. Make it work: If you don't get along with your partner's pal, keep trying. Don't give up on at least being friendly with the BFF because he's an important person in your mate's life.



If you're from New York or a fan of ABC's reality show Shark Tank, there's no denying that you've heard of Barbara Corcoran, the savvy real estate mogul who started her business with only \$1,000 (given to her by an ex-boyfriend) and parlayed it into a billion dollar company. She now sits among a panel of business tycoons (all men) as they battle it out to invest their hard earned money into the next big idea or product pitched to them by starving entrepreneurs. For Corcoran, a woman who has been building a business all of her life, she says the show was perfect for her. More than a successful entrepreneur, she is a wife and mother, something she proudly speaks about. She says that most of what she learned about business was by watching her mother helm a household of 10 kids. Her inspiring story is chronicled in her latest book, *Shark Tales: How I Turned \$1,000 into a Billion Dollar Business*.

We had the privilege of speaking with Corcoran, who offered advice to single women who are interested in starting their own career. She also shared what she's looking for when choosing a new business. The answers may surprise you; it's not all about the numbers. Take a look at what she had to say:

What's it like being the only woman on the panel?

It's a HUGE advantage as much as it is a huge disadvantage. The advantage is that no cast remembers my name; they say "Oh, you're the girl on the show." So since I'm the only girl there they can't mix me up with any of the guys who are in suits because my legs are hanging out.

The disadvantage I find that during the actual taping of it is that I have a woman's voice, and they have a camera on each of the sharks for a full 12-hour day. If you were to get a hold of my unedited tape, it would be mostly me saying, "Uh, huh, ah," trying to get attention, and the men mull right over me. Not that I'm a shrinking violet, but they have bigger voices. So I have to work twice as hard as the guys there.

For the entrepreneurs, I think it's an advantage because they are quicker to trust a woman and believe what I have to say over a man regarding what I am promising to them. So there is a huge trust card there that I can leverage from being a female.

What type of products are you looking to invest in on the show and what are your goals? The things that would interest me have more to do with the individual and less to do with the product:

1. Handles Pressure: We watch people on the show unravel; they're nervous. When this happens, I immediately know if I am interested in the entrepreneur without even knowing what their business is or what they are going to say because I am watching them under pressure. You have to be really good in the bad times or you're not going to make it.

2. Salesperson: The entrepreneur must be a salesperson. There are so many people with great business ideas, and very often, the reason that they don't have success is because they can't sell their own product. If they can't sell, then I am not in, period – because they're my salesman.

3. Thankful: I'm watching to see if they're a thankful person. In many situations in my adult life, if someone isn't thankful for their family, parents, kids and their lucky breaks, then those people can become ugly partners when there are a lot of chips on the table. I want to partner with a nice person.

4. Hustler: A tremendous trait that must be there is hustle. There is no way to build a business with just having the right product. Even with the right investors on your back, and if you're on prime-time television with a national platform to sell your product, if you don't have the long-term hustle, you won't make it through the finish line.

So, what I am really focusing on is the individual. If all of those things aren't clicking in my head then I want to get out as quickly as I can. So it's less to do with the product and more to do with the entrepreneur.

What advice do you have for single women who want to start their own business?

I watch people who have saved for years and years to start

their business, and they either lose the fire or they get into a position where they have too many bills, family responsibilities, etc. The advice I would give is to start early; begin as quickly as you can and as young as you can. Also, a great thing happens when you're young — you're not afraid. The lack of fear is such powerful ammunition, because the older you get and the more experience you get you're more aware of where you may fail, and that can stop you from trying.

Many women report that they have trouble finding a man who can handle a successful woman. Are there any particular characteristics of the type of men they should be looking for?

Yes — a secure ego. This is true whether it's your marriage partner, a boyfriend for 10 years or a business partner. What's important is that the person needs to be secure enough in what they've got, versus envying what you've got. That's when the trouble starts.

You cut ties with your business partner/boyfriend in the beginning of your career. Is there any advice you can share with women who are attached to the purse strings of a man and don't feel they make it on their own?

I think this quietly erodes your own self confidence and it's a dangerous position to be in. You don't know how much confidence or ability you have until you take that leap of faith. Like anything else that you do in life, it's hard to cut the strings that aren't working for you because you don't know what you are going to replace them with. But trust me – it's worth taking the jump, because you are wasting valuable minutes of your life.

How do you balance a relationship, motherhood and career?

The truth is that I haven't done it well; I gave up on it a while ago, and simply by admitting the defeat of that it became much easier. One technique I use is that I definitely separate my business from my family and my family from my business. One day a week is Barbara's day, one day is Kate's day (my five-year-old), another day is *Shark Tank* day, and so on. Separating my life into these compartments takes a lot of stress out of being a bouncing ball.

In your book, *Shark Tank*, you outline your mother's life lessons by chapter. Do you think any of these can apply to love and relationships?

One that should apply is No. 3: If the Sofa is Ripped, Cover it with Laughter. Lesson No. 16: Sweep the Corners and the Whole House Stays Clean. Why this applies at home in addition to work is that it means whatever is bothering you, get it out right away. If it sits in the corner, it rots. You need to communicate. That lesson is key to keeping your relationship going. Lesson No. 18: Moms Can't Quit. I can't tell you how many times I was ready in my marriage to call it quits, but you need to figure out a way to make it work. Moms can't quit.

How do you apply to be on ABC's Shark Tank?

It's a simple process; you go to ABC.com and fill out the form. Pictures are optional, but television is a visual medium so I would suggest making sure you send one in.

Any last tips on *Shark Tank* or what you are looking for in an entrepreneur?

The only thing I can say is that I am looking for someone who is flexible and open. That's the most important thing to me. People that aren't open to new ideas and are resistant to change rarely work out. At this point in my life, I want to work with someone who is pleasurable.

1. Step back: If you see the situation escalating to dangerous levels, take a breather so each of you has room to settle down. Nothing good can come from a blow-out fight.


2. Seek a mediator: If things are too heavy for the both of you to handle on your own, consider bringing in an outside



Cupid's Advice:


There's no doubt that it's important to know your partner well before you decide to spend your life with him or her, but it's not necessary to know every last detail. Here's why:


